Reasoning

- Manifesto commitment Delivery of 20mph speed limits on roads outside schools by 2018
- Roll out across residential roads by 2020
- Contributed towards two main council priorities:
 - A cleaner, greener borough
 - Active, healthy communities
- Main objectives:
 - Improve road safety
 - Improve conditions for walking and cycling



Consultation

- Borough-wide consultation July -Sept 2015
- Launch event, public notices, website
- 3 Options Schools Only; All residential Roads; All residential plus areas of high footfall



Consultation Responses

649 Responses; good support for comprehensive Option

Do you support 20mph speed limits on all residential roads which do not carry through traffic?

Yes	444	69%
No	202	31%

Do you support 20mph speed limits on some sections of main roads where there is lots of pedestrian activity? (see appendix 2 for the consultation map showing where 20mph limits were proposed)

Yes	424	66%
No	222	34%



Design Principles

- Consultation involve residents; various options
- Commitment to monitoring speeds
 post-implementation.
- Self- Enforcing No hard Measures, signs and lines only.
- Any existing physical traffic calming retained.
- Relocated/added VAS to suit; All Zones Full time


Implementation

- Schools 2018
- Remaining residential 2020
- Also 'A' and main strategic roads around:
 - Schools
 - Town center's
 - Train/tube stations

- Joining up the dots, linking into other LIP & Developer schemes.
- Complete
 Neighbourhood Areas.
- Boundary Neighbouring Authorities, Ealing and Richmond.

Bath Road, Chiswick	Residential through	25.4mph	24.6mph
Staveley Road, Chiswick	Residential	27mph	23.6mph
St John's Road, Isleworth	"B" road with bus routes	25.5mph	23.2mph

- Self Enforcing of 20mph Zones.
- Clearer process for existing Safety Cameras to switch from 30 – 20mph, where zones introduced.
- Pursuing the Croydon model with mobile speed cameras
